**Recorder Yarbrough and Prominent Area Veterans to
Cut Ribbon on New CCRD Veterans Service Office on Flag Day**

(CHICAGO) – To better serve military veterans who visit the Cook County Recorder of Deeds to record or retrieve their discharge records, Recorder Karen A. Yarbrough and a Dedication Committee including Secretary of State Jesse White and Comptroller Judy Baar Topinka will cut the ribbon on a new CCRD Veterans Service Office on Flag Day, June 14.

"Recording a DD-214 military discharge with a County Recorder means that a family member will always know where to quickly retrieve a copy to access benefits, especially if the veteran is incapacitated," Yarbrough said. "Our new Veterans Service Office will be a place for veterans and their families to sit down and relax while our staff handles the details of their visit, and I can't think of a better way to thank our veterans than by helping them."
